 - Fire Safety Training for staff members










Financial Sustainability

- Institute solid financial controls in policy & action including Fund Balance, Purchasing, Capitalization of Fixed Assets, Credit Card Use, Investments & an annual independent financial audit
- Provide a Living Wage to all employees
- Provide health, vision, dental & retirement benefits plus employee assistance program
