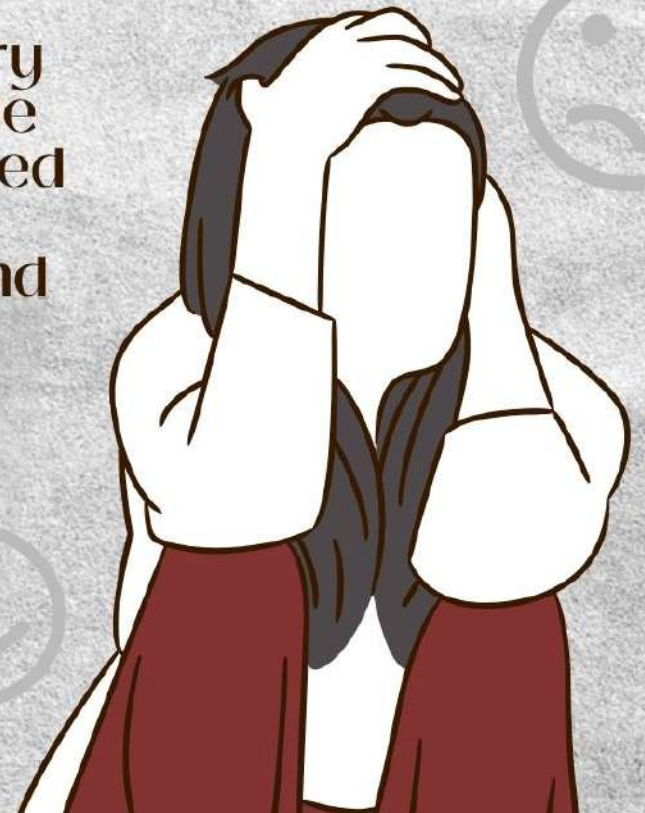

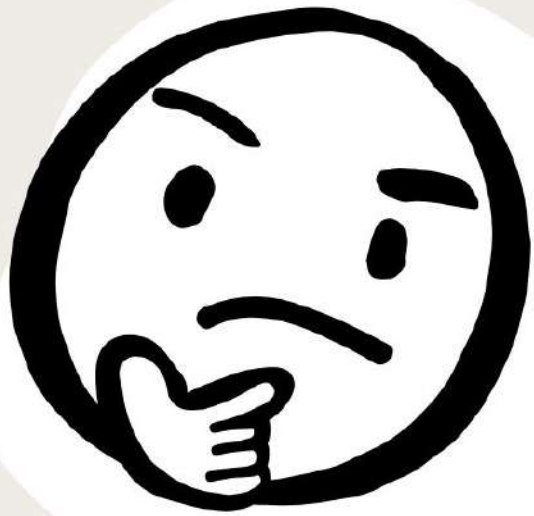


Analyzing My Library program:
