



dral School library collection is thoughtfully curated for readers of all abilities erests. Students in kindergarten through sixth grade visit the library for 45 minutes with their class one day of their 6-day cycle.

School Library class time includes listening to a picture book, selecting and out books, and participating in a variety of enrichment activities. Starting in arten, students learn to distinguish between fiction and nonfiction and are ged to select books based on their interests. As they progress, Library/Tech integrate technology to support research and curricular projects, starting in third grade and continuing through sixth grade.

School students have access to a diverse range of books, including graphic ction chapter books, nonfiction, and Young Adult literature. The library also a versatile learning space, where students can study, conduct research, read sure or academic purposes, and relax with friends before and after school.
