
You asked, we listened. 

LIBRARY BUDGET VOTE AND TRUSTEE ELECTION THURSDAY, APRIL 11, 2019

PUBLIC HEARING

When: Monday, April 8, 2019 Time: 7:00 p.m.

Where: H. Dutcher Community Room This is an opportunity to learn about the proposed budget, to ask questions, and meet Trustee candidate, Minita Sanghvi.

VOTING DAY

When: Thursday, April 11, 2019 Time: 9:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. Where: H. Dutcher Community Room

What are we voting for?

- Budget: The public will be voting on a proposition to collect \$5,205,672 in school district property taxes in Fiscal Year 2019-2020 to operate the Saratoga Springs Public Library. This is a 2% increase in the amount that was approved for FY2018-19. The last increase was 0.5% in 2017, and the previous increase was 0.5% in 2015.
- Minita Sanghvi, of Saratoga Springs, is running unopposed for election to the library's board of trustees. She was previously appointed to fill a position vacated by Darren Drabek, who moved out of the district.
